Title of lesson

African Capitals Review Game

Purpose ("why" of the lesson, where and how does it fit into the course/curriculum)

Matching exercise will be collected and checked.

Assessment (how does this lesson relate to assignments/homework/readings)

Matching exercise worksheet.

- △ Class will be broken down into 4 groups. (Named teams 1, 2, 3, and 4)
- ▲ Each group will be given a set of flash cards containing all of of the capitals.
- A Groups will be asked to present the capital of a given country.
- A Groups will be given no more than 45 seconds to present a flash card in answer to the question. Students should not call out answers or show flash cards in a manner that will allow other groups to see the answer.
- The teacher will walk around to check every group's answer. Groups that answer correctly will receive a point, groups that answer incorrectly will receive no points.
- A The team with the most points at the end of the game will be declared the winner.
